BOOK REVIEW

ŠESTÁK, Z., ČATSKÝ, J. (ed.): PHOTOSYNTHESIS BIBLIOGRAPHY, VOL. 14, 1983. — SPB Academic Publishing, The Hague 1986. 406 pp.

This volume summarizes photosynthesis bibliography of 1983. It is the 14th volume of the series and the number of references is larger than 4000. The bibliography covers almost all the fields of photosynthesis research, from the molecular level to the atmospheric CO₂ level effect.

The references are arranged alphabetically by the first authors' name. An author index allows the reader to search references by any name of the author or co-author of the paper, or by the editor's name of the publication. Two other indexes are available. The subject index provides very comprehensive items and is useful by combining two items. The plant index uses general names in Latin or in English. Regrettably, in this index no combination of items is available to screen at least the field of the reference. This is important for the more common species which are often cited.

It is clear that a careful checking of all the references has been made and that this series represents very much work.

This book is a convenient access to the bibliography of photosynthesis, to start a survey of a new subject or to check the exhaustiveness and the validity of a bibliography.
